3's A.M.* Children must be 3 by August 1.
• Two-day 9:00-11:30 Th-Fr \$80 per month
• Three-day 9:00-11:30 M-W \$100 per month

3's P.M.* Children must be 3 by August 1.
• Two-day 1:00-3:30 M-T \$80 per month
• Three-day 1:00-3:30 M-W \$100 per month

4's & 5's A.M.* Children must be 4 by August 1.
• Three-day 9:00-11:30 M-W \$100 per month
• Four-day 9:00-11:30 M-Th \$120 per month

Each Wednesday, our youth and pre-teens gather to share a meal together, learn about God's Word, and enjoy hanging out and playing large group activities.



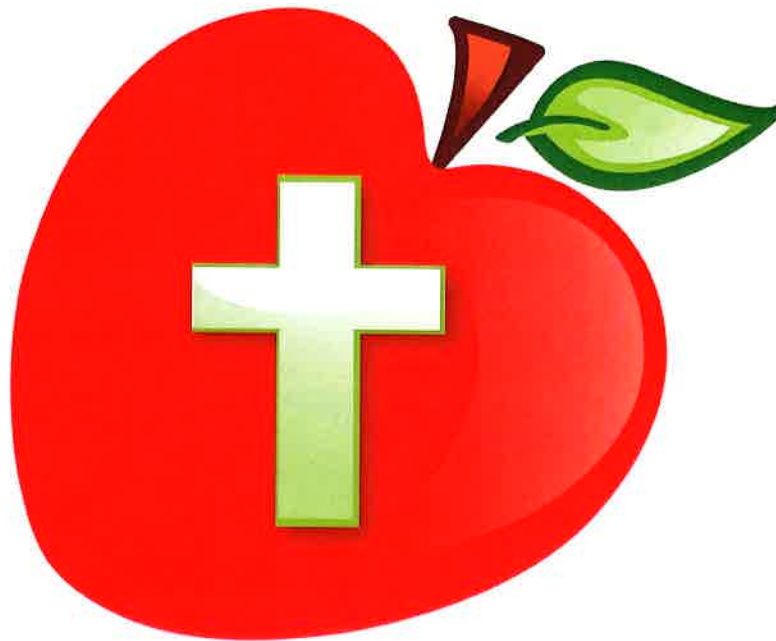

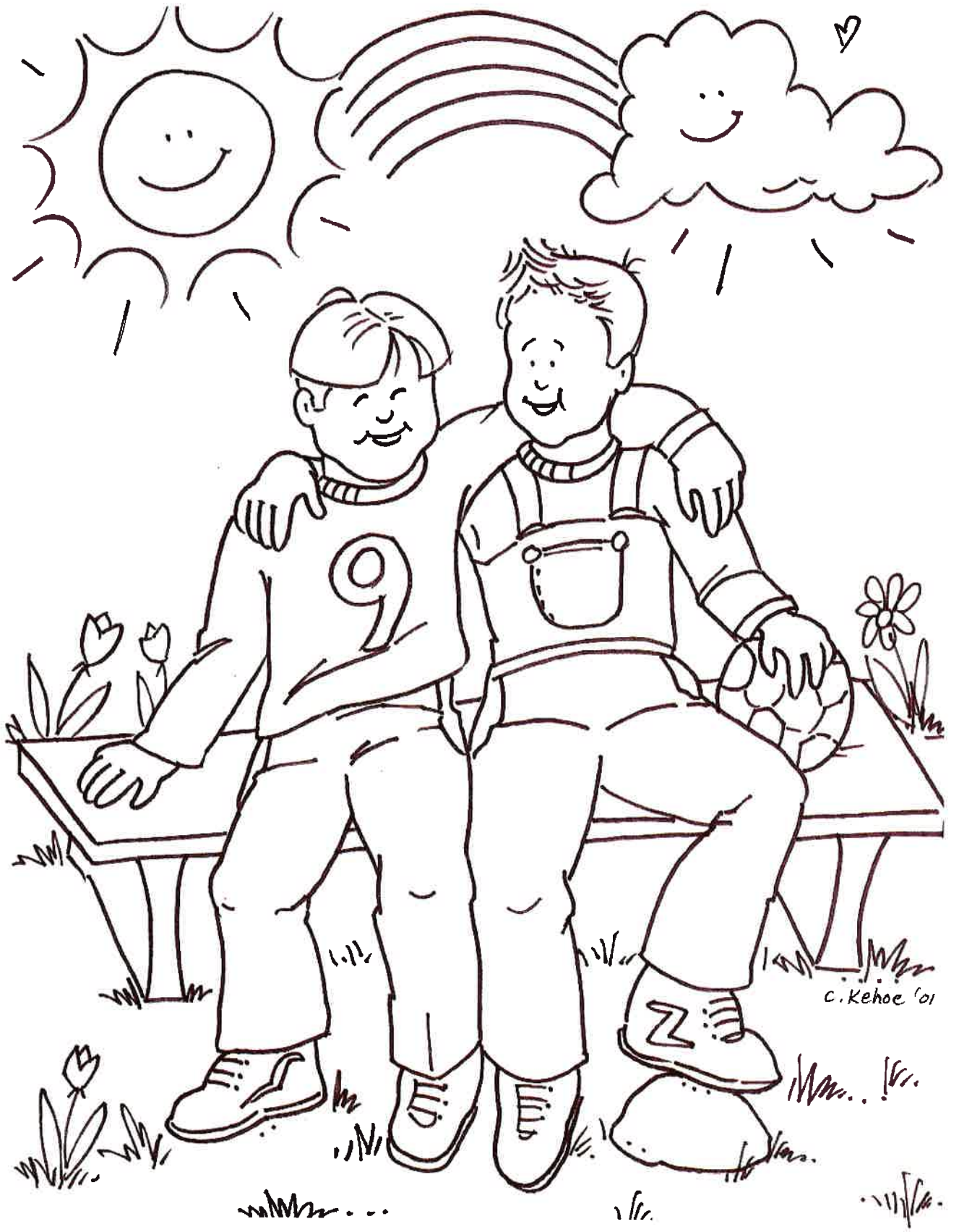
